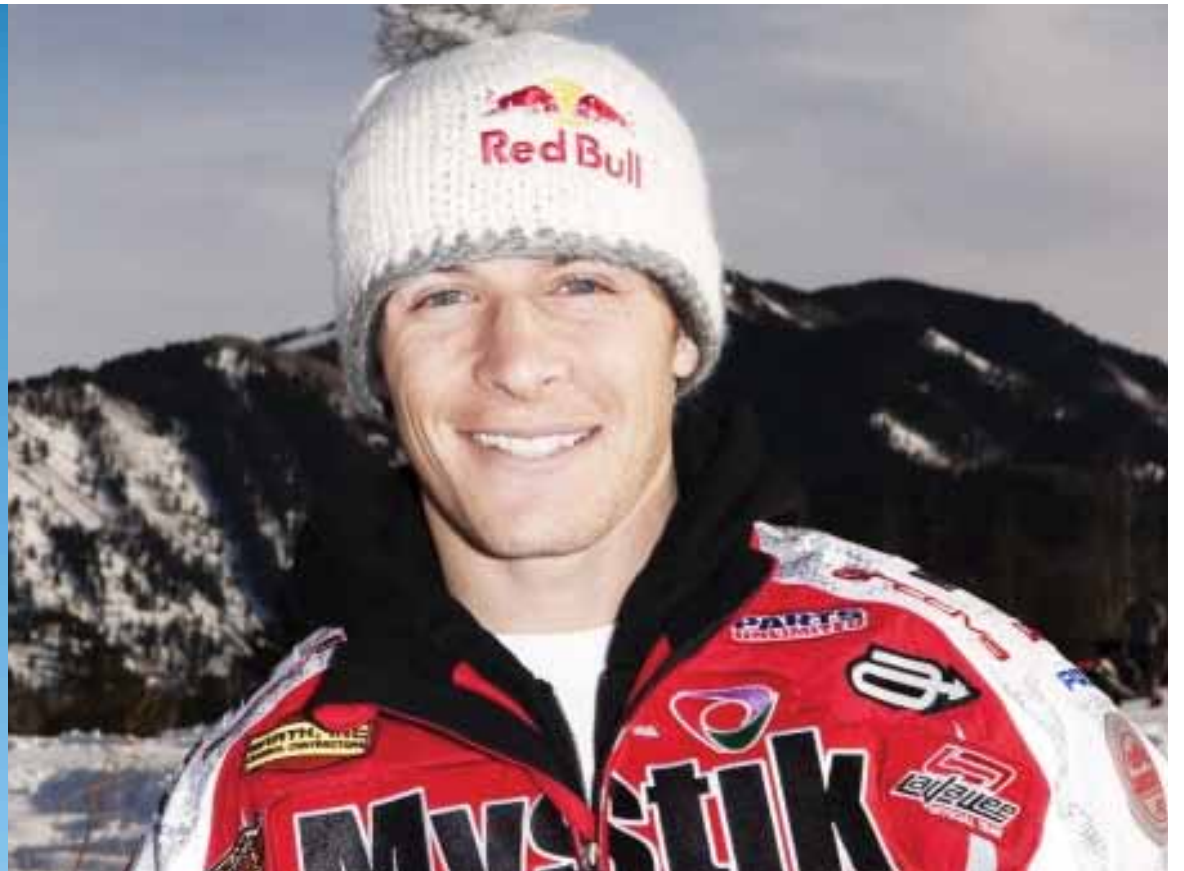

Finally SB 648 was passed by our legislators. It does include the separation of the liquid fuels tax monies by the number of snowmobiles and ATV's. We are currently working with the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to establish a Partnership and increase the Registration Fee. We will keep you informed of any significant developments. Plans are being made to provide you with the opportunity at the Show to voice your opinion on the increase in the Registration Fee. Listen for announcements when you are at the Show.

PSSA has several committees. We are asking for anyone who is interested in any of the committees listed in the Keystone Snowmobiler to send me an e-mail with your information. All committees are in the process of being revamped. **An important committee which the Board has just approved is the Fund-raising Committee.** We need your ideas and help to make PSSA financially viable.

My comments given at the Conservation and Natural Resources Advisory Committee meeting held at Benezette on September 21, 2016 are in this Keystone Snowmobiler and on the PSSA web-site. (See page 4)

Hello, PSSA Members,

There are just a few things to report this month in regard to PSSA's grants program:

Sixteen snowmobile clubs continue to work on their Round I mini-grants of DCNR Round 20 projects. I'm sure you will notice on the trails in the upcoming snowmobile season the effects of the hard work on these projects. The last day of this mini-grant round is April 15, 2017 and reports will be due April 30, 2017.

There are a few clubs who have extended their Round III mini-grant of DCNR Round 19 in order to use in the upcoming season the fuel that was purchased with their mini-grant. Hopefully there will be plenty of snow for them to groom the trails. This round ends April 1, 2017, with reports due on April 15, 2017.

If you have worked on or are currently working on PSSA's Signs Projects (GPS-ing trails or posting signs, etc.), please make sure that you have submitted your volunteer time and mileage to the PSSA grants office. You can download forms to submit this information from the PSSA website under "Organizations and Club Members", then "Downloadable Documents for Clubs".

We hope to have news soon of another grant award. We are waiting to hear whether or not our DCNR Round 22 application is awarded.

That's all for now from the PSSA Grants Office.

CONSERVATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING

September 21, 2016

Members of the Advisory Council, Elected Officials, Fellow Citizens

Thank you for your presence here in the PA Wild's. I appreciate the opportunity you have provided for the general public and myself to speak with you about what we all love – The PA Wild's

I am Liz Krug, the President of the Pennsylvania State Snowmobile Association (PSSA).

I am well acquainted with this beautiful area of PA as I was born in St. Mary's and graduated from Duquesne University in nearby Pittsburgh. I graduated with a Master's Degree in Education Administration and have continued my education for many years in mathematics, science and education in general. I am now "sort of" retired but continue to work with volunteers in the PSSA and other snowmobile clubs.

PSSA is one of the oldest volunteer recreation groups in the state. It has been in existence since the late 1960's. It is composed of seven Executive Board members and Regional Directors/Assistant Directors who represent the 12 regions of the state. Presently there are 57 snowmobile clubs with the Bald Eagle Snow Riders being the latest to join our Association.

Snowmobilers have always "paid their way". Clubs groom and maintain trails/trailheads on private, public, game commission, state and

national forests. These are volunteers who raise \$4000 – \$20,000 a year to help cover expenses. In addition to the above PSSA and the clubs also help promote snowmobile recreation and provide Safety classes throughout the state.

The economic significance of snowmobile recreation according to our latest economic survey is \$132,000,000. Snowmobiles are the life-blood of many rural communities' economy in the winter months.

I am here today to discuss the "Restricted Fund" and to promote a state-wide snowmobile program.

The "Restricted Fund" is composed of both a \$1,000,000 liquid fuel tax reimbursement and the funds received via the registration of ATV and Snowmobiles. PSSA members worked for 15 – 20 years to get this tax included in the Restricted Fund. As you know SB 648 has divided the dollars from this fund into two accounts based on the percentage of users of snowmobiles and ATV's. However the liquid fuels tax is based on gas used not on how many snowmobiles/ATV's are registered. If this last statement is true why is this money divided by numbers of recreational vehicles rather than gas used? I do not see this as fair to all who use gas for their recreational vehicles.

PSSA has been meeting with representatives of DCNR for several years. The Registration Fee of \$10 is one of the lowest in the country. It does

not pay for a statewide snowmobile program. PSSA applies for an umbrella grant in the name of snowmobile clubs via Federal Highways/ Rec Trails Program. This is not money from the Restricted Account. In turn clubs apply for these "Mini-grants". PSSA reviews and approves these grants. A total of 25+ people in addition to DCNR personnel who ultimately review and approve these grants are involved in this process. Reports are also written for each round and a final report for the whole grant is given to DCNR. This process is both time and paper intensive. PSSA must cover 10% of the grant total. This money is then returned to PSSA after the final grant report is approved and the grant is closed. This can take several years and ties up monies that are needed for other projects. Yes, we like the money but the amount of paperwork and time involved is disheartening to many. The process needs to be streamlined.

There are more efficient ways with the advances in technology to do the above. Groomer trackers, gps, digital programs etc. if implemented across the state would make this process more efficient and transparent. A formula for club/DCNR reimbursement based on mileage/hours used to groom and maintain trails would streamline this process.

Club members pay a membership fee in addition to the Registration Fee for their sled(s). Some pay an additional fee to belong to PSSA.

There are many snowmobilers who do not belong to either a club or PSSA. They have the opportunity to ride 6000 miles of snowmobile trails for \$10 a sled and do nothing else to help maintain trails. An Increase in the Registration Fee for all with money earmarked for trail maintenance/grooming activities for all clubs/DCNR could be used to equalize the playing field for all snowmobilers.

PSSA has been a Partner with DCNR for many years. PSSA is willing to continue to work with DCNR and establish a state-wide program to do the above.

What is the future of snowmobile recreation in the PA Wild's? PSSA Regional Directors are making plans to take elected officials and others such as you on a snowmobile ride. Of course this will depend on the weather. Furthermore, PSSA is hoping to establish a PSSA/Wild's snowmobile ride in this area.

I have information and a draft proposal for the above.

I am willing to answer any questions and discuss further.

Thank you for your attention and cooperation with this Proposal.

14th ANNUAL HYNER MOUNTAIN SNOWMOBILE CLUB SAFETY COURSE MOVED TO SUNDAY

In an effort to avoid previously-reported scheduling conflicts with the PA Game Commission's family-oriented Saturday black bear hunt, the Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club has decided to move its 14th annual Pennsylvania Snowmobile Safety Course to Sunday this year.

Accordingly, the course will be taught on Sunday, November 20, 2016 at the Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club lodge, which is located along Route 44 approximately 6 miles north of Haneyville, PA in Clinton County. The course is free for all participants.

Pennsylvania's Snowmobile Law requires youngsters between the ages of 10 to 15 to earn a safety certificate before they may lawfully operate a snowmobile in the state, except upon lands owned or leased by their parent or legal guardian.

The goal of the course, which was developed and is administered by the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, is to develop safe attitudes in all keystone state snowmobilers. Student manuals and workbooks will be utilized to illustrate the sport's basic principles and safety concepts. The course content will cover winter clothing, machine safety, and snowmobile laws and regulations. Class participants qualify for their certificate by completing their workbooks and

achieving a score of 80% or better on the final examination.

Course instructors include Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club members Rich Ebersole of Cornwall, PA and Harrison Langley, Jr. of Palmyra, PA and "Keystone Snowmobiler" co-editor Henry Hartman of Hanover, PA.

Parents are to accompany their children to registration so that the required forms may be completed. Registration begins at 7:30 AM; class starts promptly at 8:00 AM and will end by 4:00 PM. The Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club will provide lunch.

Enrollment for the course is limited to a maximum of 30 students and pre-registration is required. Parents are encouraged to stay for the day to attend the course with their children or join the club's members in the cozy living room area of our spacious sleep-in lodge for a day of conversation and fellowship around our mountain stone fireplace. With direct access to the Sproul State Forest trail system from our parking area, come discover why we say that the Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club is "a great place to park your sled and rest your head"...

The Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club is located approximately five (5) miles north of Haneyville. From the intersection of Route 44 and Hyner Mountain Road, continue north (straight) on Route 44 and look for Pat Reeder's Tavern on the right. At the end of Pat Reeder's driveway, look for the gravel road on the left which is marked by a green road sign: "Reeders Addition Lane". Make a left onto Reeder's Addition Lane and proceed to the end where the lane splits into three (3) separate driveways. Take the middle, gated driveway to the Hyner Mountain Snowmobile Club lodge which is a large, 2-story brown building. The club's parking area encircles the lodge.

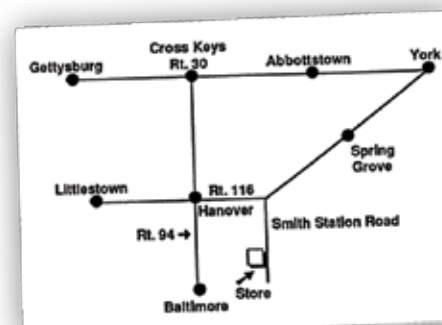

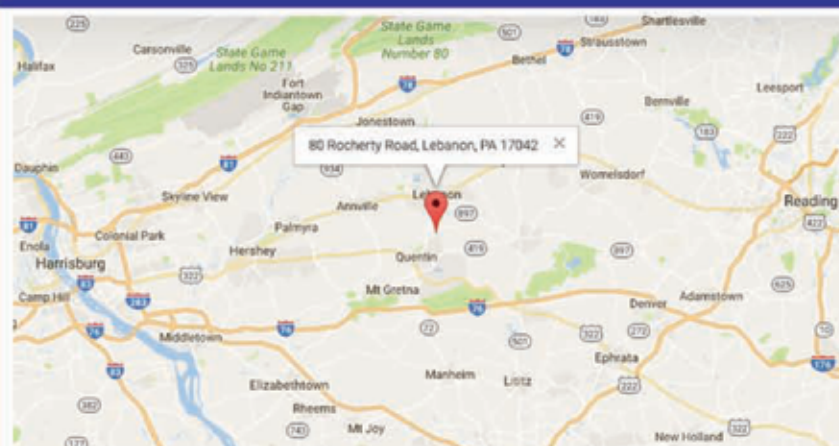

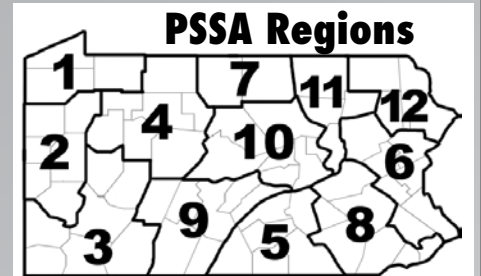

recreationists of all kinds.

The research work consisted of a thorough study of three market segments. The segments were: Young Adventure Seekers – aged 24-36; Family Fun seekers – couples with children between the ages of 8-16; and Empty Nesters – individuals aged 50-65 who enjoy youthful activities and participate in many outdoor activities. Individuals within these groups were contacted by phone and electronically from across North America and they also participated in the key target groups with 50 individuals in each one of three groups, held in the US and Canada.

Recently, similar research was performed in Canada by the IPSOS Public Affairs Group. They generally verified the initial study conducted by Consumer Insights in 2006. The research shows that the three groups, collectively, were excited about activities that included having fun with friends and extended family and they enjoyed sharing their recreation choice with others. The groups all agreed that their activities did not require significant athleticism and exercise was universally seen as a byproduct rather than a goal or focus of the outdoor recreation. The respondents believed they had four common benefits that they all wish to achieve in their activities: (1) a strong sense of

social interaction with family and friends, (2) relaxation by disconnecting from their day to day routine, (3) fulfillment of accomplishing an activity, and (4) it was particularly important to do something that was out of step of their day to day activities to relax.

The research also showed that individuals (a) liked to have the chance to feel like a kid again; (b) snowmobiling and being outdoors is the most important time to feel alive and escape the confines of daily life; (c) this was an opportunity to connect with nature, (d) an opportunity to connect as a family and to improve connectivity with each other. Most participants stated that it was a great way to end a great weekend.

The research also told us that Winter Recreation requires a certain amount of heartiness that is not necessarily required for the summer. The preparation time is longer and the amount of daylight hours is shorter. Plans can easily be disrupted due to poor driving conditions, even though we all wait for the snow. School routines impact on winter recreation in a way that are not present in the summer, and therefore need to be accounted for.

Interestingly, many individuals in the study group did not understand where snowmobiling occurs. If they did not own a snowmobile and never went snowmobiling, they had no idea where the trails and riding areas were located. They knew nothing about snowmobile clubs, associations, and/or related businesses. They also stated that many non-snowmobilers knew snowmobilers but never participated in the activity due to various reasons. Many of the respondents stated that their friends never asked them to go snowmobiling, so they never had the opportunity to do so.

When individuals were asked if they wanted to go snowmobiling on a scale of 1-10, they rated the desire to go snowmobiling a 9. Individuals of all age groups expressed a high level of interest in snowmobiling and they are hopeful that the winter season will allow them to participate in the activity and get them out on the snow.

It is because of these positive results and the research work that was conducted in 2006 and reinforced in 2015, that the snowmobile manufacturers initiated the "Take a Friend Snowmobiling" campaign. The campaign is designed to encourage snowmobilers to invite non-snowmobilers – whether they are friends, family, or elected officials – to go snowmobiling. It is known that once individuals go snowmobiling, their likelihood of snowmobiling again in the future improves substantially. We also know that when individuals snowmobile with friends, they will often join the club and/or association that their friends may be involved in. Taking a Friend snowmobiling is a great opportunity to expand club membership and Association membership throughout North America.

We are all encouraged to help grow the snowmobiling family and plan to take a friend snowmobiling this winter.

After a short trip on the snowmobile take your friend to your club house, a club meeting, a snowmobile show, and to your local snowmobile dealer so they can get a feel for what the sport can entail. Give your friend a map and show them the trails and riding areas. Invite them to events they might enjoy..... IT IS FUN!

2016 USED SLED (And Other Toys) CORRAL

Another year has gone by and we are getting ready for the annual PSSA Powersports Show again this year at the Lebanon Expo Center.

If you are not familiar with how you can sell your equipment at the Powersports Show, here is a quick explanation: Bring your equipment and walk to the Used Sled Corral table. Fill out a 3-part carbon-less form for each item. You can save time by printing a sample form from the website (www.papowersports.com) and filling in all the info before coming to the show. Then transfer the info to the 3-part form. Pay the fee for each unit. Our friendly volunteers will then unload sleds and move trailers into the building. We do the rest!

On the form you will list the selling price and indicate if you are firm or negotiable on that price. You will list a bottom line price if you choose negotiable. Our volunteers will not reveal the bottom line to a potential buyer, but will attempt to get the highest price for you. If we sell your unit, we collect the money and hold it for you. Machines or money must be claimed no later than 5 pm on Sunday, an hour after the show closes.

Those machines that are not sold during the show are often sold later, as a result of someone seeing it at the show. They tell another person in the days following the show, that person calls for info, and the deal is made!

For current PSSA members, the fee for each unit (sled, trailer, motorcycle, or ATV) placed in the Corral will be \$25.00. Pay the fee when you arrive with your machine.

For the non-members, we will not require that they join PSSA, but the fee for them will be \$60.00 per unit. If they wish to join, they will save ten bucks by doing so, as the consignment fee will be \$25., and the membership is \$25., for a total of only \$50.00.

For those persons buying a unit, PSSA members can make a purchase with no extra charge, non-members will be charged a fee of \$35.00.

We expect most non-members to recognize the value of PSSA membership and make a decision to join (so they can save the extra ten bucks!). If a person does not wish to join, PSSA gets the additional ten dollars!

One very important feature of the Used Sled Corral is the great group of volunteers that make it happen. Over the years we have learned to know a number of fine folks who help at the Corral, some help a few hours and others help many hours. Each and every one is appreciated; we can't do it without you.
