

The spring season is always a busy time of year for us with our annual Upper Pine a beautiful morning with a fair amount of Creek Trout Tournament held each May, which is always the weekend after Mother's Day. This year we had a whopping \$14,000. in cash and prizes on our big prize board with 408 registered participants. This year, there were two \$500 cash prize winners along with the top prize of \$1,000. in cash also being taken. The angler has to catch one of the club's 250 tagged fish; bring the fish in "live condition" to the check-in station at the organization's clubhouse on Route 6 and then draw a numbered Ping-Pong ball. The number on the ball is then matched with that number on the 8 x 16 foot board on our front porch that identifies what prize is won.

Now with our tournament behind us our attention has turned to our Adopt A Highway cleanup program. Our clubs' two-mile stretch Think Snow of RT. 6 started just west of the clubhouse and ended at the Log Cabin Inn at the town of Rexford.

### PENNSYLVANIA SNOWMOBILE DEALER HISTORY 1960's-70's

In early 2017, we started putting together the history of people and businesses that sold snowmobiles "back in the good old days". After starting with York County, the momentum was already going and we expanded it state-wide. And we need your help!

Snowmobiles started to become popular in the early 1960's. By 1970, there were about 130 different manufacturers, and there were more than 265 brand names of snowmobiles being sold!

Snowmobiles could be bought at small "mom & pop" shops, (often in garages), as well as at large stores such as Sears, Montgomery Ward, and JC Penney.

During 1973-75, the so-called "energy crisis" combined with several poor snow winters spelled the end of many of these manufacturers and brands.

Today, there are four (4) major manufacturers of snowmobiles. That number has remained constant since the 1985 model year. We are interested in the places that sold snowmobiles not later than 1982-84 or so.

We are attempting to record the history of as many of the "old time" dealers that sold snowmobiles as we can. They are listed in alphabetical order by Counties, then alphabetically by Town names. What is included below is just a small sample.

The number in ( - ) behind each County name is the total known so far. The second number is the number of snowmobile dealers in that county today, if known.

We have 45 counties so far, of 67 total. Please help us with the rest!




