# MOVING FORWARD



**Have a Safe and Enjoyable Fourth of July – Thank you to those who have worked to secure the Freedoms we all enjoy.**

**House Bill 544 which deals with landowner protection was committed out of committee. However, it still has a long way to go until it is voted on in the House and Senate. Continue calling your State Representatives and Senators. This bill is very important to our trail system. Thank you to all those who made the first calls. We need to continue the calls and emails and show our Representatives that HB 544 is very important to us.**

Last month I mentioned the mapping project for phase three of the gps/signage program. I am happy to report that representatives from Region 1, Region 4 and 11 have completed their training. This program permits clubs to manage their trails/make changes on the PSSA sponsored trail mapping website. Access to make changes is limited to a secure password to be used by a designated person from the club. It is a work in progress and will be evaluated after these clubs have experience using the new site.

**Plan to attend the Annual PowerSport Show October 27 -5pm – October 29 – 3:30 pm**

**Features include:** Friday night (weather permitting) the “**Tough Trucks**”. The **Tractor Pulls** will return for the Saturday event. An **Antique Car Show** is being planned for the Sunday event. This show has something for everyone. The Show will have our vendors, used sled corral, auction, used clothing booth, ticket sales and PSSA clothing as always. The trailer and ATV drawing will be held at 3:30 pm.

**Year Two planning** of the “Snow Trails” video project is almost complete.

Year Two will feature the Poconos and Huntingdon County plus Erie County and the PA Wild’s. We are in need of sponsors from the PA Wilds – Benazette/Clearfield/St. Mary’s area. One may have the good fortune to see an Elk during a snowmobile ride in these areas! Any business, tourism bureau or person can help sponsor an area. **This is a great opportunity for your trails to be given national attention through his TV show.** The “Snow Trails” TV program is currently changing to Sunday morning at 8am. **Three bridges** in the Allegheny National Forest area are now complete. Two bridges connect trails in the ANF and are used by other recreation groups. The third bridge connects trails between Kinzua Bridge State Park -Mt. Jewett and the ANF. This bridge can also be used to connect trails to the east thru Smethport, Clermont and Potter County. I extend many Kudos to all those who worked or planned these bridges. They are an important part of our trail system.

Since the current fee of \$10 has been the rate for many years most members recognize the situation as in need of a sizable increase. If we want the trails to continue we will need to embrace a sizeable increase in the next year or two. You should plan ahead for an increase.

**Is the glass half-full or half empty?** I think it is important to keep a perspective on this fee. What does \$25 - \$50 buy today? (Haircut, good dinner, case of beer, nice blouse/shirt, DVR) What did the sled cost that you are riding? The clothing and equipment that you purchased?

**It is important to note that Nothing has been finalized and discussions will continue with DCNR.** As of this writing I am waiting for more information. **We need facts before we can discuss**

anything.

**Meanwhile, we have sleds which are not registered or carry insurance.** Clubs need to work with the local State Police and establish a Safety Check Program for their area. The Snowmobile Fund needs every sled to be registered. Clubs need to insist on this at their events. Why increase the fee if we are not going to have law enforcement on our trails. **It is up to each one of us to promote trails in Pennsylvania.**

**Clubs** will receive information concerning the next round of grants in the near future.

PSSA lost two champions of snowmobiling in Pennsylvania. Don Clouser passed away several weeks before the Membership Meeting. He was on the Board and worked with the PowerSport Show. Ray Walker passed away at age 105. He provided lively commentary at some of the PSSA Membership Meetings. Ray has been a “Friend” of PSSA for many years. They will be missed.

**Tickets for chances on the two trailers donated by Blizzard and an ATV donated by the dealers** will be in your mailbox shortly. Please be generous. All proceeds are used to support PSSA programs. **Think Snow! (Let’s do a SNOW dance!)**

## GOD'S COUNTRY BLACK FOREST SMC LOST A GOOD GUY

It is with great sadness that I have to report the passing of one of the charter members of God's Country Black Forest Snowmobile Club. On Sunday, June 11, 2017 Ray Kempf passed away at Carlisle Regional Medical Center; just weeks shy of his 90th birthday. Ray was born June 28, 1927.

Ray was a great guy who loved anything outdoors. He began riding motorcycles in the 1950s; his last bike was a 2008 Harley Davidson trike (see photo below). Like most of us "old guys", Ray was bit by the snowmobile bug in the early 1970s. Ray got his first sled, a 295 Polaris Colt, from a small dealer near his home in Oberlin, PA, Don Flack. It did not take too many trips to Cross Fork, PA with the Flack crew before Ray and his wife, Darlene, were hooked. A few years later, Ray and Darlene bought a second home in Tioga County. It was not by accident that the home was only a few hundred yards from a main trail. They loved to ride together; very rarely did you see Ray without Darlene. My family and I met them in 1978 or '79 and began riding with them on a regular basis. There wasn't anywhere in Tioga or Potter County that Ray could not take you to. In 1980, when talk of starting a snowmobile club in Germania was being discussed, Ray and

Darlene were more than ready to sign up. For many years, Ray and Darlene devoted many hours and days to the club. Ray never shied away from any project at the club. Trail maintenance was his forte, he loved to be outdoors. Making and putting out trail signs every fall, taking them down in the spring, cutting up fallen trees, and even mowing trails in the summer. Mowing kept the hay seeds out of the air box of his sled (but that's another story).

Ray retired in 1999 and made Tioga County his fulltime home. For the next ten years, he devoted even more time to the club.

In 2010, Ray was forced to move back down state for health reasons. It was a sad day for Ray and the club. He gave up snowmobiling then, but remained active in other activities such as riding his Harley throughout Central PA.

Ray was truly one of the "good guys." I will miss him as so many others will. May God bless and keep you, Ray.

# ANF REPLACES TWO TRAIL BRIDGES

The Marienville Trail Riders Snowmobile Club in conjunction with the Forest County Snowmobile Club and the Pennsylvania Snowseekers Snowmobile Club worked with the US Forest Service and were recently able to replace two trail bridges with two new treated timber bridges. The first bridge that was replaced is over the Bluejay Creek just off of the Bluejay Creek Road (SR 1003) on snowmobile trail #11. The old bridge was built in 1991 but was too narrow for any of the clubs' groomers which required the replacement.

Duffy, Inc. of Smethport, PA was the contractor for the installation of the two trail bridges. Some contractor installation costs were saved by having the Forest Service and the snowmobile clubs complete some of the bridge installation work. The Marienville Trail Riders Snowmobile Club was able to have a crew do some mulching and seeding at the Bluejay Creek Bridge after the bridge installation was completed.

The second bridge that was replaced is located approximately a half a mile south of Duhring on snowmobile trail #1 (ASL). The Marienville Trail Riders Snowmobile Club also tore out and hauled away the old Straight Run Bridge to help save some contractor installation costs.

Both bridges are located on a multi-use trail system that the Forest Service provides to the public. The Bluejay Creek Bridge not only is used for snowmobiling in the winter but also for ATV/OHM riding in the summer. The Straight Run Bridge is used for snowmobiling but also for the equestrian use.

Thanks to the Marienville Trail Riders Snowmobile Club, Forest County Snowmobile Club, Pennsylvania Snowseekers Snowmobile Club along with the US Forest Service, and the Pennsylvania DCNR, Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission, and Pennsylvania DEP. Once the work started, it took only one month to complete both bridge installations. Great job to all involved!

A special thank you to Terry Wood, President, Forest County Snowmobile Club for doing all of the paper work involved with the administration of the federal and state funds used for the purchase and installation of these new treated timber bridges.

Now if Mother Nature cooperates for this winter, the installation of these two bridges should make grooming and riding of our snowmobile trail system much nicer.




