Happy New Year!







Several members from the US Forest Service along with residents from Bob's Trading Post also were in attendance. A possible solution for operating the large Forest Service Groomer that is parked at Bob's Trading Post just north of Kane will hopefully be in operation for the upcoming snowmobile season. This groomer is an instrumental piece of equipment that needs to be in operation to maintain the trail in and around the Longhouse Trail. This 35 mile Longhouse Trail can provide up to seventy miles of breathtaking views and snowmobile riding and if properly groomed




