
Board Officers were reelected for another year. Thank you for your confidence in what the Board has been doing the past year. However, we need everyone's input. Your insights and comments are appreciated.

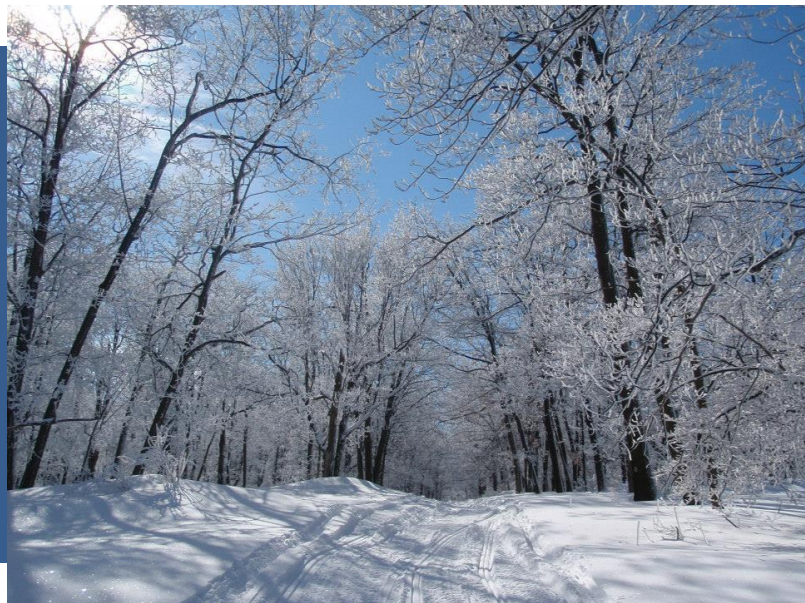

3. On August 1, 2020, 15 volunteers removed graffiti from Beam Rocks in Forbes State Forest. Sadly, vandals had spray painted the rocks both here and in Ohiopyle, Pa. Volunteers previously removed the Ohiopyle graffiti.
4. The PA Powersports show held in Lebanon, Pa. is cancelled.
5. (ISMA) International Snowmobile Manufacturers Association president Ed Klim gave the following information which may enlighten you: Snowmobile sales in the United States in 2020 was 51,036 units.
