Dutch Trail Cutters Celebrates 50 Years

Last fall, in 2021, we started to tell you about the history of the Lancaster County based Dutch Trail Cutters Snowmobile Club which was formed in early 1971. In June of that year, a committee was appointed to look into land that might be available to build a future clubhouse. Then in November, the minutes of a club meeting show that there was discussion on a spending limit of \$10,000.00 for this land, and to be located within 100 miles of Lancaster County.

During the September 12, 1972 meeting, 2 members, Dave Auker and Galen Myers, reported finding suitable land. The members in attendance voted to purchase 5 acres in Havice Valley, near Milroy, PA. The property borders Bald Eagle State Forest. The cost of this was \$ 3,500.00, and the group approved to take out a loan and settle for the property by October first. At the same meeting, they also voted to limit the number of club members to 50 families.

At the October 10th meeting, it was noted that the settlement for the property took place on October second, and a loan for \$3,000.00 was secured from the New Holland Farmers National Bank. Grass drags were scheduled for the last 2 weekends of October. The members also planned an "outing" to visit the newly acquired property for November 12th, 1972.

Today, 50 years later, the Dutch Trail Cutters are still a 100% PSSA club! Every member of the club is also a member of the State organization, supporting snowmobiling across the entire Commonwealth. In future articles, we will reveal how the clubhouse was built. The Dutch Trail Cutters Snowmobile Club has memberships available. PA Snowseekers

The PA Snowseekers have been doing major repairs to Trail-1 south of Russell City near their Clubhouse at Highland Corners, PA in the Allegheny National Forest. There was about ¾ of a mile of trail that has been washing away from a clogged drainage pipe.



Members Rich Hayes, Scott Thomas, Bruce Moody, James Carr and Larry Mosier along with some local friends of the Club, Roy Stillman and Ollie Bowen, worked several days over multiple weekends to correct the situation. Meals were provided by Member Loretta Hayes and delivered to the work crew.

Heavy equipment was brought in along with gravel, rock and about 24 feet of 24-inch pipe to reroute drainage away from the trail. The eroding trail was filled in, graded, leveled and smoothed out with the support and direction of the Allegheny National Forest representative. The next step will be to reseed the trail to prevent further erosion. The cost of materials, equipment and fuel will be partially covered by Grooming Funds obtained for the 2021/2022 season. A special thanks to members Scott and James that provided the heavy equipment to make accomplishing this project feasible.

Polaris says 230,000 of its snowmobiles need a safety fix before being used again

Polaris is issuing a stop ride/stop sale order due to a fire safety issue the company has seen on certain snowmobile models, the company said Tuesday. It is working with the Consumer Product Safety Commission on the problem.

Polaris Inc. told customers Tuesday (August 30th) to bring certain snowmobile models to authorized dealers and have them fixed because of a fire hazard from degraded fuel in gas tanks, especially after extended storage.


