This information is important to document what PSSA is asking in terms of grants for our clubs. PSSA also needs up-to-date club information. Clubs need to be kept informed of issues, comments, concerns and possible grants.

Additional State Forest Roads Opening Across The State For Hunting Seasons, Other Outdoor Activities

Harrisburg, PA -- Hunters and outdoors enthusiasts heading into Pennsylvania's state-owned woodlands this autumn will find additional roads open in 18 of the 20 state forest districts, the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) announced today.

"This improved accessibility, coupled with DCNR's promotion of deer hunting, benefits forest regeneration and the overall ecosystem," said DCNR Secretary Cindy Adams Dunn. "DCNR will be opening more than 533 miles of state forest roads that are normally only for administrative use. They again will be available to hunters, hikers, foliage viewers, and others visiting state forestlands this fall."

The PA Snowseekers 2022 Golf Outing




Glendale Lake SMC

A big shout out to Ed Holden who graciously donated forty-four ton of 2RC stone toward the North Meadow Trail improvement project. Thanks Ed!




