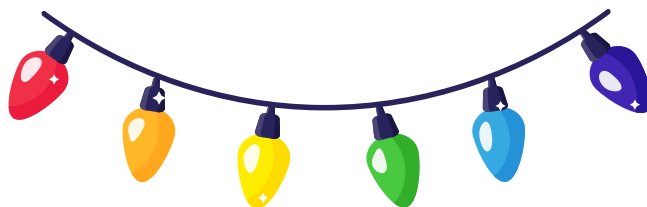

The programs we will be working on in 2024 are as follows : The Spring Membership Meeting with the location to be announced, registration increase and we hope to bring the Powersport Show back. # Snowmobile Club Help Needed



PSSA is contracting with MapGears this fall for a trail map app - a needed enhancement to the snowmobiling experience in Pennsylvania. The first year will be a pilot program with a limited number of state trails and a limited number of participating club trails. Getting the MapGears application up and running will be a work in progress as we will continue to load more trails, more trail conditions, and more features next year. Robert Housley, currently on the PSSA Trail Committee and the Region Nine PSSA Director, will be the super user administrator to coordinate the implementation and each club will have someone assigned to keep their trails updated. We are very grateful to Zippo Outdoors for their generosity! We ask everyone to support this company that supports PSSA and snowmobile riding enthusiasts whenever possible.

**We are looking for local clubs that want to be part of the first year pilot program with their local trails and trail conditions shown on the new PSSA PA Map and APP.**

To Beth and Jim, thank you both for ALL that you do for our Club and we sincerely appreciate your efforts and contributions!



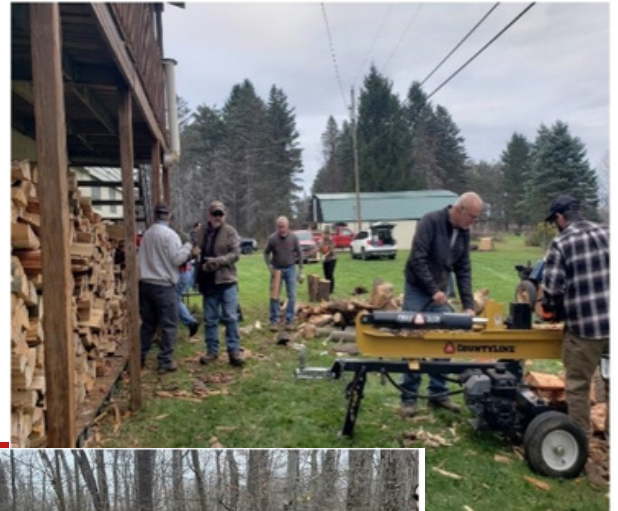


# PA Snowseekers Fall Activities

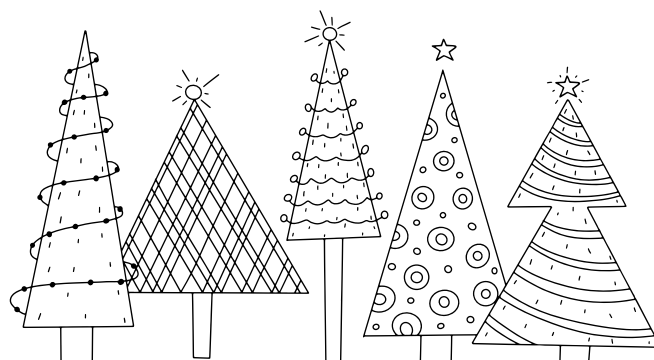

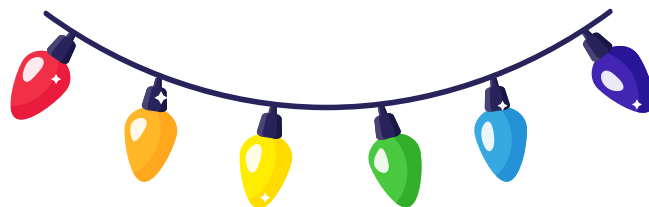

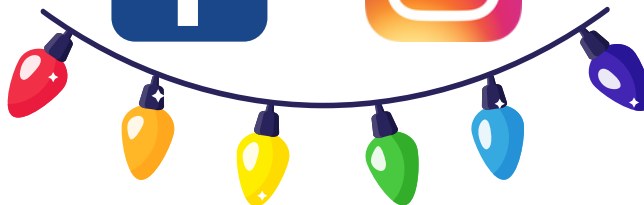

# What to Bring Along!

**New to snowmobiling? Here's a handy check list of items to take with you on your ride.**

**Map and Compass:** Most states have good trail maps. Topographic maps provide the most useful information for navigating terrain because they show the area in three dimensions. Purchase a good orienteering compass, and learn how to use it with a topographic map.

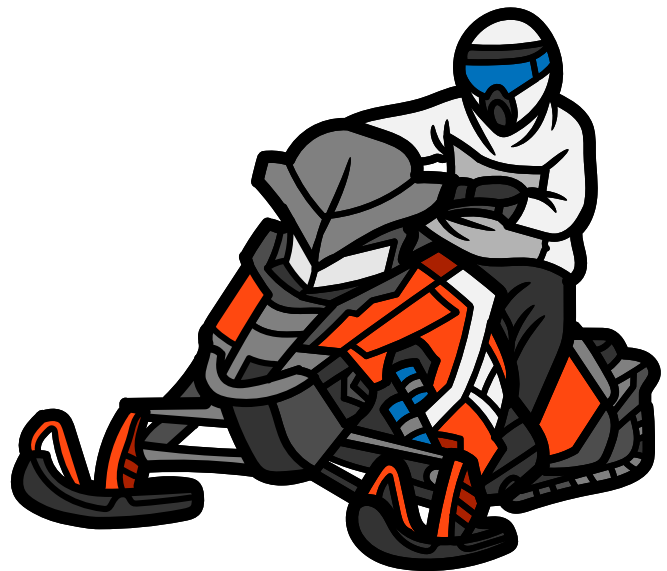
**First-Aid Kit:** Carry a well-stocked first-aid kit, and take a first-aid course so that you'll know how to respond in an emergency.

**Survival Kit:** In addition to the items listed above, you should carry a survival kit. Although the contents will vary based on conditions and the length of your outing, a survival kit could include:

- Emergency blanket
- Emergency food and water (enough for one or two extra days)
- Flashlight
- Hand axe or saw
- High-energy snacks such as candy bars
- Knife
- Nylon rope
- Plastic whistle
- Pocket mirror
- Signal flares
- Snowshoes
- Sunglasses
- Tarpaulin
- Waterproof matches
- Water purification tablets

Other useful items:

- GPS unit
- Mobile phone
- Radio for weather reports

# Get Your Snowmobile Ready to Ride!

Watch the following video to help you get your snowmobile ready for the upcoming season. Among the topics covered are: removing the hood and side panels (:29); removing dryer sheets (1:07); reinstalling your drive belt (1:14); reinstalling your battery (2:18); checking your wiring (3:17); removing fogging oil from the engine (3:37); replacing spark plugs (3:55), draining, recycling and replacing fuel (4:10); adjusting your track and suspension (4:20); inspecting your carbides (4:43); checking fluid levels (4:57); and reinstalling your hood, speedometer and side panels (5:17).

## Vintage Winter Weapon: A 1964 Polaris Sno-Traveler Pacer Snowmobile

This is a 1964 Polaris Sno-Traveler Pacer snowmobile that has been restored back to full working condition. It's now being offered in running condition ready for winter adventures out of Salem, Oregon.

The Pacer K80 D shown here was named for the fact that it was powered by a Kohler 8 hp engine (K 8.0) and it's capable of 25 mph on snow with a total weight of 435 lbs. Pacers like this were typically used by anglers, hunters, farmers, trappers, and by the public for general leisure.
