WHAT DOES PSSA DO?


- Promote snowmobile recreation via Website (www.pasnow.org) and Facebook (www.facebook.com/pasnow"Pennsylvania Snowmobiling"





SURVEY OF PA SNOWMOBILERS AND PA SNOWMOBILE CLUBS

- 75% of PA Snowmobilers are campers or snow chasers
 - If there isn't snow in my back yard, is there snow at camp?
 Or where can I ride?
- Solutions:
 - More Snowcams done, more up this year
 - PSSA Trail Conditions done
 - If there isn't snow in my back yard, where can I ride
 - Give me maps, GPS and let me know if the trails are rideable
 - Where can I park, get gas, eat, and stay?

WHY DOES THIS MATTER?

- PA is a snowmobiling state, in spite of what some may say
 - #7 or #8 in miles of snowmobile trails in the United States
 - More trails than most Canadian Provinces, except Ontario and Quebec
 - In 2022, PA was #12 in number of snowmobiles registered at 32,000
 - Now with 41,000 registered sleds, PA could be in the top 10
- PA DCNR Secretary Dunn has moved Recreation to the top of her agenda
- PA Governor Josh Shapiro has appointed an Outdoor Recreation
 Director and given him a staff and budget


PA HAS SNOW!

- Quebec, Ontario, Maine, and NORTH all lacked snow this year
- Many years Potter and Tioga Counties, ANF have more snow than:
 - All of NY except Tug Hill
 - All of Ontario except Cochrane and Abitibi Canyon
 - All of Quebec except two regions (Abitibi/Temiscaming and St Zenon)
- Sometimes that snow is:
 - In the Laurel Highlands, Potter, Tioga, Erie, RB Winter, SP or ANF
