Snow Angel Giving

Thank you to all who give so generously to our Snow Angel Fund. For nearly twenty (20) years, the generosity of PSSA's members in purchasing annual raffle tickets and making donations has enabled the Association to contribute nearly \$200,000 to aid in the care of children with special needs.

Through PSSA's Snow Angels Children's Charity, grants (up to \$500 per child under the age of 18) are available throughout the State to aid families with children having severe medical or physical problems.

Recently, PSSA provided 13 month old Kylie Schneider from Northampton, PA a Snow Angel donation. Kylie is being treated for a brain tumor. She is a beautiful little girl with a beautiful smile. She has gone through so much already in her short life.

Kylie requires special care and so her mother is with her every day. Special food is required for a feeding tube. They are unsure how long their insurance wil cover the therapies.

On July 7th, Kylie turned 1year old. She is a little warrior. She continues to show determination, resilience and a fight to be here with her family. Her most recent scan has shown no new tumors, no recurrence in her original tumor area and stable scans of the spine in which there appears to be no active tumors. Her spinal fluid has remained free of cancerous cells. She receives daily therapies Monday through Friday for PT, OT and feeding therapy. She continues to meet her goals and milestones in all areas.

Pittsburgh Irish Festival

September 6-8

Bloomsburg Fair

November 2-3


